The 8th International Biennale of Contemporary Art will be held in Tashkent and Bukhara



On October 8 - 14, the VIII International Biennale of Contemporary Art will be held in Tashkent and Bukhara. Its official opening ceremony will be held on October 10 at 17:00 in the Central Exhibition Hall of the Academy of Arts of Uzbekistan.

Famous artists and curators from France, Italy, England, Germany, Austria, Spain, Poland, USA, Argentina, Australia, Macedonia, Israel, Russia, Ukraine, Dubai, India, Japan, Korea, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan will present their projects. Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan, and as members of the international jury will be, including the famous contemporary artists Dmitry Bulatov (Russia, artist, art theorist, whose works were presented at various exhibitions and festivals, organized and oversaw more than twenty international projects and exhibitions around the world) and Olga Kiseleva (France, director of the Institute of Science and Art at Sorbonne University, chief editor of Plastik Art & Science).

After the opening of the Biennale, it will continue its work until October 14, in the Central Exhibition Hall of the Academy of Arts of Uzbekistan, as well as at eight sites in Tashkent and Bukhara.

In Tashkent:

In the Tashkent Youth House (opening October 11 at 15:00); In the Gallery of Fine Arts of Uzbekistan (opening on October 11 at 17:00); In the gallery Bonum Factum (opening October 12 at 18:30); In the Tashkent House of Photography (opening October 13 at 18:30).

In Bukhara:

In the Local Lore Museum in the Ark fortress (opening October 12 at 14:30); In the museum Sitorai Mohi Hossa (opening October 12 at 14:30).

The program of the Biennale will also include lectures on the contemporary art of famous foreign contemporary artists, art theorists and curators. In particular, on October 9 at 5:00 pm in the conference hall of the Central Exhibition Hall of the Academy of Arts a press conference will be held for the media with the participation of foreign artists - participants and members of the international jury.

On October 10, from 10:00 to 12:00, lectures will be held on the development of modern art with the participation of foreign guests and in cooperation with the Scientific Research Institute of Art Studies in the conference hall of the Union of Artists of Uzbekistan.

On October 13 at 14.00-17.00 an international conference "Life of art with technology in the context of the present" will take place with the participation of famous lecturers of modern art: Dmitry Bulatov, Olga Kiseleva, Andrey Yepishin, Lyudzhin Yun, Akbar Khakimov, Normurod Negmatov and others.
